Webb pulled out all the stops throwing in the Hilfing Grabit, The Imperial Viper and the Hi-Temp Stay-On horseshoes in an attempt to thwart



his opposition. Charles Browning said it don't bother me none and proceed to pitch 6 out of 10 with the difficult Grabit shoe and 4 and 5 out of 10 with the ultra light GXL shoe! Charles did have a fair amount of trouble pitching the Stay-On though, only managing one ringer out of 10 throws. Everyone did have a difficult time

has been put in similar to that found at the Chalybeate Complex. This should keep the heat in and make it nice and warm this winter. As you can see, a lot of work has gone into the floor striping and building of the portable pits. These four courts are complete except for installing more blue clay. Plans are to complete this site with



three more courts on the front side for a a seven court facility. Room will be left on the front near the entry door for a seating area and table setup for running pitching events.
