From the KHPA History Files: The Harry Henn Memorial Tournament 1970-1978

## Profile Of The Harry Henn Memorial



March of 1970 would see the beginning of the Harry Henn Memorial Horseshoe Tournament. This tournament was originated to honor the memory of former Ky. State Champion and horseshoe great Harry Henn. Harry was a former officer of the KHPA during the 1940's, a solid state title contender and State Champion from 1934-36. Harry was also a

Greater-Cincinnati Champion and Northern Kentucky Champion and a master of the <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> flop turn. Harry was the father of 7-time state champion Bill Henn and fellow horseshoe pitchers Cliff and Chick Henn. Harry passed away in March of 1951 at the age of 56.

The Harry Henn Memorial was held each March at the Day-Bell Indoor Horseshoe Courts and Club in Dayton, Ky. The Day-Bell Club was located on Clay Street at the old Wadsworth Watchcase Co. building. The tournament intended to be a big event on the Kentucky Day-Bell winter schedule and draw in some of the country's top pitchers. The tournament was scheduled from 1970-1979. I can find no record of the 1973 & 1978 tournaments and it is my guess that the 1979 tournament would have been cancelled. Don Moore was the man in charge of the Day-Bell site and the owner of the building chose not to renew the club's lease on the building in early March of 1979. The tournament was regularly attended by Harry's sons Bill, Cliff and Chick, fellow state champion and competitor, James "Pop" Johnson and many of Ohio's top pitchers. # Bill Henn's Win in'75

Bill Henn would win the tournament in 1975 going undefeated. Bill received a real test from Pop Johnson! As reported by Don Moore: "The top game of the afternoon was between Henn & Johnson, Henn defeating Johnson 50-46 in a 94-shoe game. Ken Klugler taking third place defeated Johnson, in Johnson's second loss 51-45, Klugler averaging 70.5% to Johnson's 68.1%. Pop Johnson was 5-2 with a 72.3% average and Ken Klugler was 5-2 at 68.4% overall.

## 1974 HHM In Depth

On page 2 of this history file, I have an in depth look at the 1974 Harry Henn Memorial with a game by game breakdown of the Class AA, tourney championship. The field was loaded with Champions. This class was attended by four Ohio State Champions; Donnie Roberts, Stan Manker, Paul Focht, & Jim Knisley. Pop Johnson, who moved to Ohio in 1964, was a 4-time Kentucky State Champion & Bill Henn was the reigning Kentucky State Champion. Ohio's Gene Reno was a World Championship contender, & Kentucky's Stan Lovelace was a solid State contender. Of interest note the high shoe totals pitched in this class with the high level of play and 50 point games.
